Algarve in Portugal – 12th – 13th September is the stage of Round 5 of the FIA GT3 Championship and will be Lanik's first race since his successful Spa 24 hour debut where he finished 3rd.



Porsche Motorsports supported driver, Marco Holzer will partner Niki in the no 12 Prospeed GT3 Cup car in Portugal.

Niki, currently second in the Porsche drivers championship is optimistic of a double podium finish this weekend, "this will be the strongest driver paring so far in the No 12 Prospeed car, I am delighted that Porsche Motorsport have allowed there charger to take part in the GT3 Championship and I hope to impress them with a good result" Holzer is a regular in the GT2 Championship with Prospeed.

Team Boss Rudi Penders is unable to attend this weekend due to prior commitments but Lanik hopes to impress his team manager also with a run of solid points scoring positions with the aim of strengthening his position in the

Porsche Drivers championship and the Overall GT3 championship.

Unofficially practice will take place tomorrow morning at 10 am, followed by the two Qualifying sessions in the afternoon. Both races take place on Sunday.
